- Received Knowledge
 - ...focus on nursing education in universities; RN shortage, graduate nursing education; social, biologic, medical theory
- Subjective Knowledge
 - ... Peplau (1952); philosophers Dickoff, James, Wiedenback; Nsg on nursing; functional nursing; Abdellah, Orlando, Henderson reflections on experience
- Procedural Knowledge
 - ...(separate; connected) focus on *separate* eg. theory development approaches, methodology, statistical analysis; less on application
- Constructed Knowledge
 - ...integration & building on previous studies, pt. experience, literature, etc
